Riding as One Intro Course

Finding Your Balance and Independent Seat while Developing Deeper Unity & Partnership through Connection, Movement and Timing

The following is covered in this clinic:

Mind/body integration where love and leadership is present at all times. This balance is most important as it binds you both in a level of “Emotional Connection” and comfort, thus supporting your horse’s need for safety.

This is achieved through awareness, intention and congruent action by you. Any issues or challenges that arise between you and your horse during this time will be addressed, thus allowing time for you both to work through any challenges while being coached.

Caroline begins the first morning with discussion and demonstration. She will then lead you through specific ground exercises designed to deepen trust, connection, communication, partnership and leadership between you. These are key elements to developing safety and confidence within you and between you. Once these new patterns, ways of Being and doing are created, you will notice a calmer, more clear and present you and a deeper more wanting partnership from your horse.

After lunch you will be asked to resume your ground work for connection purposes and take it to the mounting block, the “Permission Stage” to riding. Once on your horse, you will be lead through a series of riding exercises and patterns that continually reinforce your connection and communication with your horse.

General Clinic Information

Format

Caroline Rider will be the instructor at each clinic. Rider Horsemanship will take the first 10 students to register and pay the deposit for each clinic. There will be a waiting list after the participant spots are booked. If there is a cancellation of one of the participant spots we will contact the names on the waiting list. If you are contacted to fill a spot we will require a non-refundable full payment to confirm your participation in the clinic.

Caroline pays individual attention to each and every participant in her clinic. If an apprentice is available, they will accompany Caroline to all 2012 Horsemanship Clinics. This is to ensure that in addition to direct group and one-on-one instruction directly from Caroline, owners can always be assured of help when they need it most.

Clinics begin anytime between 8-9am and usually wrap up around 5pm, with a 1.5 hour lunch break. The actual progress depends on the participants and their horses. Caroline’s ultimate goal is to help each participant:

1. Gain a better understanding of their horse through education & insights into equine behavior.
2. Incorporate that knowledge with newly acquired skill sets learned.
3. Create a more fulfilling and rewarding relationship with their horse.

Auditors

The cost to observe is \$30.00 per day. Children 12 & under are free. Seating may be limited at select clinics. Please note - we may ask observers to bring lawn chairs at these clinics.

Observers are asked to reserve ALL questions for after the clinic. Training products, DVD's and apparel will be for sale at each clinic.

Please note, the following are not allowed: video taping & pets.

Deposits/Final Payments

To confirm your participation full payment is due upon registration, with signed paperwork and forms. Please be sure you are willing to commit to attending the clinic as payment is NON REFUNDABLE.

Cancellation

You are responsible for filling your spot should you cancel. Please check in with us should we have a wait list.

We reserve the right to cancel, and/or reschedule due to lack of registration or severe weather. Clinics are held rain or shine.

Clinic Rules and Policies

By signing up to participate in, or audit, a Rider Horsemanship Clinic, I am stating that I have read, understand and agree to the following rules and policies:

1. Full payment & ALL forms are due 30 days PRIOR clinic participation.
2. Clinic openings are on a first come, first served basis. If the clinic is full, your name will be put on our wait list.
3. There is a charge for auditing and is subject to specific format.
4. Refunds for cancellations are as follows – full refund prior to 30 days before clinic with replacement from wait list; audit fees are non-refundable. Refunds will be processed immediately of refund criteria being met.
5. No stallions, no exceptions.
6. No “Green” horses: horses with less than 5 rides.
7. Kids under 12 years old receive free audit if accompanied by paying adult.
8. Mandatory: copy of current NEGATIVE coggins, and vet records (Rhino Flu Vaccination included). You will not be accepted otherwise.
9. \$35 fee for NSF checks.
10. All participants must sign a liability waiver.
