Introduction to an Intuitive, Clear & Communicative Approach to Horsemanship

In this 2-day experiential workshop participants will learn the fundamentals of the Epona Approach™ (www.taoofequus.com) and the Tao of Horsemanship™ Approach to being and doing with horses.

Participants will engage in a series of informal lectures and non-riding activities designed to develop their leadership, relational, intuitive and emotional intelligence skills.

This experience is appropriate for emotionally secure teens and adults who are seriously interested in exploring the transformational potential of human-horse interactions. No prior riding experience is necessary.

Cost: \$650/participant

Includes: working with Rider Horsemanship's herd, lunch, snacks, drinks and workbook.

General Clinic Information

Format

Caroline Rider will be the instructor at each clinic. Rider Horsemanship will take the first 6 students to register and pay the deposit for each clinic. There will be a waiting list after the participant spots are booked. If there is a cancellation of one of the 6 participant spots we will contact the names on the waiting list. If you are contacted to fill a spot we will require a non-refundable full payment to confirm your participation in the clinic.

Caroline pays individual attention to each and every participant in her clinic. If an apprentice is available, they will accompany Caroline to all 2010 Horsemanship Clinics. This is to ensure that in addition to direct group and one-on-one instruction directly from Caroline, owners can always be assured of help when they need it most.

Clinics begin anytime between 8-9am and usually wrap up around 5pm, with a 1.5 hour lunch break. The actual progress depends on the participants and their horses. Caroline's ultimate goal is to help each participant:

1. Gain a better understanding of their horse through education & insights into equine behavior.
2. Incorporate that knowledge with newly acquired skill sets learned.
3. Create a more fulfilling and rewarding relationship with their horse.

Clinic Rules and Policies
